



## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- When installing this hydraulic caliper disc brake, it is of utmost importance that it be centered evenly and squarely over the disc. This will ensure even Pad to disc contact. Proper Pad to disc clearance (for new Pads) should be 0.010 inch to 0.031 inch per side (.25mm to .79mm).
- To prevent excessive wear, be certain disc does not contact Housing (#7) or Brake Bracket (#5).
- 3. NOTE: Disc and Pads must be kept free of oil, dirt, grease, etc.
- Mount Brake Assembly using two (2) SAE Grade 8 or better hex head mounting bolts. Tighten to approximately 480 in.-lbs. (54.2 N-m).
- Connect fluid line to external fluid port. Bleed brake to remove any trapped air.
- 6. Maximum allowable pressure is 2000 psi (137.9 bar).

#### **MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS:**

# **Pad Replacement**

- 1. Disconnect fluid lines.
- 2. Unbolt mounting bolts and remove Brake Assembly from disc.
- 3. Slide Housing (#7) out of Brake Bracket (#5).
- 4. Remove worn Pads (#6) from Housing (#7).
- 5. Install new Pads (#6) in Housing (#7).
- Apply an anti-seize grease to machined "V" in Brake Bracket (#5). Slide Housing (#7) back into Brake Bracket. Check to ensure Pads (#6) and Brake Bracket float freely without any binding.

NOTE: Take care to avoid getting any anti-seize on the friction material.

7. Follow Installation Instructions to continue.

## **DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Disconnect fluid lines.
- 2. Unbolt mounting bolts and remove Brake Assembly from disc.
- 3. Slide Housing (#7) out of Brake Bracket (#5).
- 4. Remove worn Pads (#6) from Housing (#7).

### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Install new Pads (#6) in Housing (#7).
- Apply an anti-seize grease to machined "V" in Brake Bracket (#5).
   Slide Housing (#7) back into Brake Bracket. Check to ensure Pads (#6) and Brake Bracket float freely without any binding.

NOTE: Take care to avoid getting any anti-seize on the friction material.

3. Follow Installation Instructions to continue.
